

New Auction House Record

A Private Collection of Chinese Export Porcelain has smashed our house record for a single owner collection realising £ 400,000 on Friday 25th March 2011.

The collection had been carefully selected over the past thirty years and great care was taken to select items in perfect or near perfect condition for the period.

Comprising over 500 pieces totalling 348 lots, the collection included a vast range of blue and white porcelain from the Ming Dynasty through to the 17th, 18th and 19th centuries.

The collection created a huge amount of International interest with a packed saleroom, telephone lines jammed with bidders and over one hundred clients bidding live on the internet.

The auction took an exhausting six hours to complete with an amazing selling rate of 98% and just seven lots failing to find a buyer.
